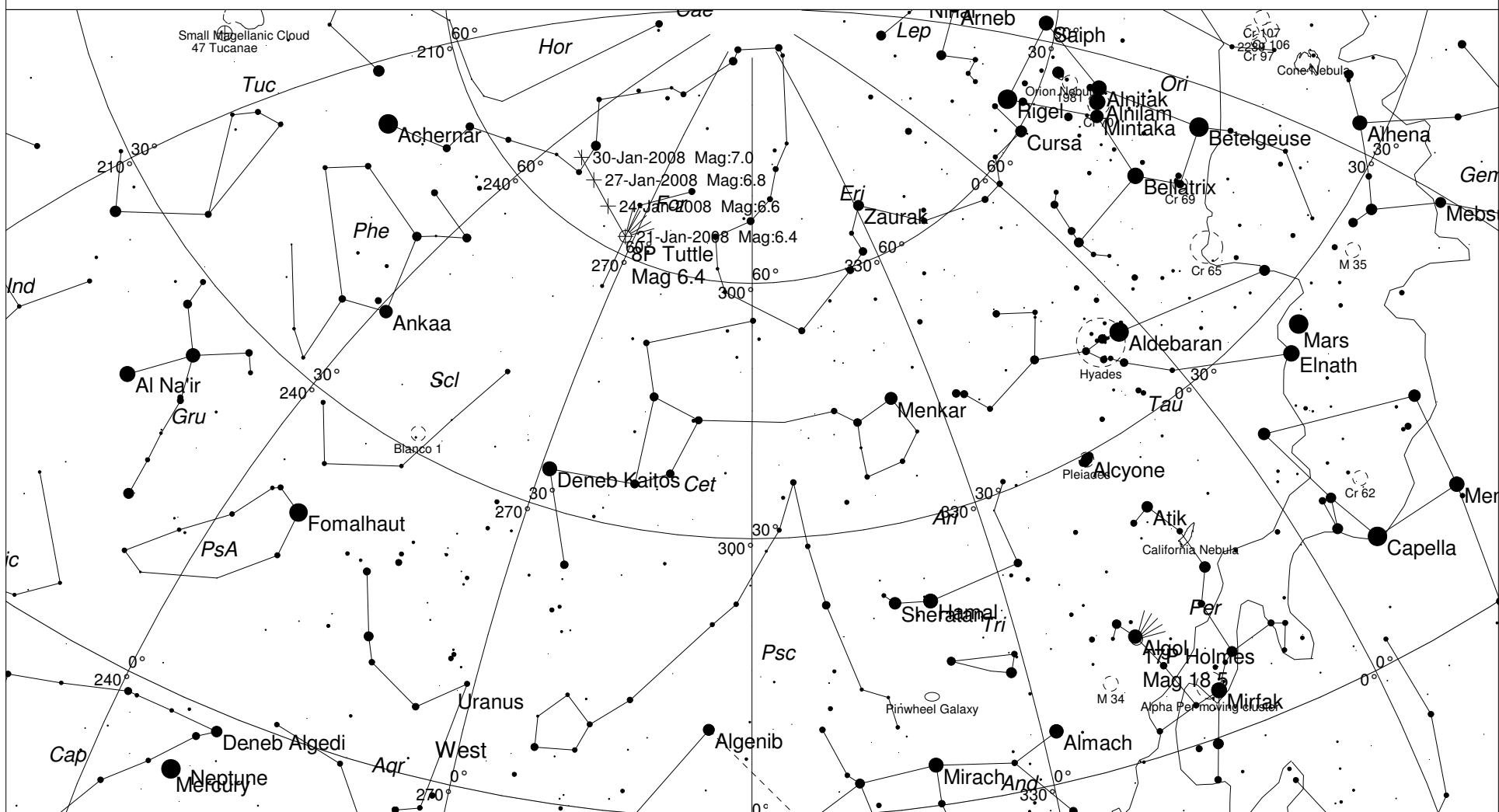


Comet 8P Tuttle and 17P holmes spotters Map

The North-western sky as seen from Adelaide at 10:00 pm Daylight saving time. Similar views will be seen as the equivalent local times (eg 10:00 pm Melbourne, 9:00 pm Brisbane). 17P Holmes is difficult to see on the map as it is nearly on top of Algol. Holmes is moving quite slowly, and will stay near Algol. Tuttle is moving fast and is high in a dark part of the sky.
